The modern standard-sized piano has 88 keys, which equals 88 notes and covers seven octaves plus a small third set. Several pianos are specially made with an extended bass range such as Imperial Bosendorfer, which has 97 keys and covers a set of eight full octaves. The piano's range has grown throughout history. The piano of Mozart's day had only five octaves or 60 keys. By 1810, the piano had reached a key range of six octaves or 72. Beethoven's few later compositions were written using this wide range. According to the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York, the piano was invented by Bartolomeo Cristofori in 1700. The piano's action is extremely complex and thus expensive, causing many of the features left by subsequent eighteenth-century producers, and then gradually reinventing and re-involving in later years. The real precursor to piano, however, is the harpsicent rather than dulcimer (scrolling down for more on these instruments). There are three known cristofori piano fortes, and three of them are found in the oldest museum collection, and are obviously quite high value. Today the term pianoforte is sometimes used to describe antique pianos marked as shown above at the Queen Anne Mansion in Eureka Springs, Arkansas. This Victorian example appeared in London in the 1800s. Although the harpsi have at least one keyboard, sometimes two, and a fairly long version, a piano is very similar, in fact it is a very different type of instrument because of its functions. While a piano hammer (like its precursor, dulcimer, shown below) and the shock absorber use to hit strings inside to make beautiful music, a harpsi have a very different performance. Keys on a harpsi strings are broken, hit in place, called either quills or leather picks plectra. Think about how the wires on the harp were ripped off with fingers while the instrument was being played, and this will give you a good idea of how the wires are manipulated in a harpsi cart. The sound produced is therefore very different. Even in classical composers in the 18th century, harpsi have been very popular. Music can be heard in a large concert hall if it is not freely carried by pianos, quite simply, like harpsi-slavic music. Entering the 19th century, most car houses included a piano commonly used for entertainment, for example during holiday celebrations.
